ST. ANDREWS SCHOOL KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

Parents and guardians are welcome to register their kindergarten age children for kindergarten classes for September. Children must be 5 years old on or before December 31, 2024 to register for classes beginning in September 2024.

A birth certificate and proof of residency must accompany all registrations. A non-Canadian birth certificate will also require proof of citizenship. Registration forms are available from the school office or on our website. You can download and print the forms from our school website by clicking here.

Please note both REGISTRATION and TRANSPORTATION (if needed) forms must be printed and completed. CHILD IN CARE forms are only required if a child is in care of Child and Family Services.

If you are aware of any kindergarten age children in our catchment area, please encourage the families to register early.

- When parking for student drop-off and pick-up, please follow the suggested flow of traffic and parking as per the map below. Please use caution when walking and driving in the church parking lot.
- For student pick-up when a bus is cancelled, please park in the church lot as per the map below or on
 River Road where permitted. Stopping/parking is not permitted on St. Andrews Road. Adults are to
 park and meet their student in the student pick-up waiting area as per the map below. Students will
 wait here until their adult meets them for pick-up. For everyone's safety, please use the crosswalk and
 follow the crossing guard's directions when crossing the street.
- For students who are being picked up early/before regular dismissal time, parents and guardians are asked to pick up their child(ren) prior to 3:00 p.m. to avoid disrupting end-of-day dismissal procedures.
- Any end of day changes to regular student pick up or bussing plans need to be communicated to the school through the planner, email or phone call to the office (204-338-7510) by 3:00 p.m.
